

Maynard Holbrook Jackson High School International Baccalaureate Diploma Program Registration Form

The **International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP)** is a two-year educational program that provides an internationally accepted qualification for entry into higher education and is recognized by many universities worldwide. IBDP students complete assessments in six subjects (usually during their senior year), and are required to complete an Extended Essay (EE), a Theory of Knowledge (TOK) class, and a Creativity, Activity, and Service (CAS) requirement. Many experts agree that the IBDP best prepares students for success in college and career, and best produces today's most active, industrious, and well-rounded citizens.

In order to qualify for Jackson's IBDP, students must have (1) passed Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II prior to 11th grade, (2) passed two consecutive years of Chinese, French, or Spanish in ninth and tenth grade, and (3) have maintained an overall GPA of at least 3.0 prior to eleventh grade. Also, any academic, attendance, or behavioral problems may be sufficient cause to rescind any acceptance that may be granted. Generally, failing two or more IB courses will result in the student's removal from the IB Diploma Program at Maynard H. Jackson High School. However, we generally DO NOT remove students from the IBDP unless they have exhibited poor academic performance or the IBDP impedes student graduation requirements. Signing also signifies your awareness that you may be responsible for the 10% to 25% of exam costs not covered by APS.
