The **International Baccalaureate Career-related Program (IBCP)** is a two-year educational curriculum that combines TWO (2) or more college-level IB Diploma Program courses with a complete career-related pathway of study. It is centered on the core components of language development, service learning, a reflective project, and a Personal and Professional Skills (PPS) class.

*In order to qualify for Jackson's IBCP, students must (1) have already passed one or more of a series of Career, Technical and Agricultural Education (CTAE) Pathway courses, and (2) have maintained an overall GPA of at least 3.0 prior to eleventh grade. 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PLEASE READ CAREFULLY:

By signing this form, you understand the commitment of time and effort your child is undertaking if accepted into the International Baccalaureate Career-related Program at Jackson High School. This commitment includes agreeing to keep your child in the IB Career-related Program for at least one school year. Signing this form also verifies that you are aware of and have committed to completing the Reflective Project, Service Learning and Language Requirements, the Personal and Professional Skills (PPS) course, as well as the applicable internal and external assessments that are required by the International Baccalaureate Organization. Any academic, attendance, or behavioral problems may be sufficient cause to rescind any acceptance that may be granted. Generally, failing one or more IB courses can result in the student's removal from the IB Career-related Program. However, we generally DO NOT remove students from the IBCP unless they have exhibited poor academic performance or the IBCP impedes student graduation requirements. Signing also signifies your awareness that you may be responsible for the 10% to 25% of exam costs not covered by APS.
