

Maynard Holbrook Jackson High School International Baccalaureate Career-Related Program Registration Form

The International Baccalaureate Career-related Program (IBCP) is a two-year educational curriculum that combines TWO (2) or more college-level IB Diploma Program courses with a complete career-related pathway of study. It is centered on the core components of language development, service learning, a reflective project, and a Personal and Professional Skills (PPS) class.

In order to qualify for Jackson's IBCP, students must (1) have already passed one or more of a series of Career, Technical and Agricultural Education (CTAE) Pathway courses, and (2) have maintained an overall GPA of at least 3.0 prior to eleventh grade.  IB Biology SL (recommended for students with at least a 'B' in AP Biology)
 IB Chemistry SL (recommended for students with 95% or higher in Honors Chemistry and a strong interest in chemistry)
 IB Math Analysis SL (recommended for students that have taken Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II prior to 11th grade)
 IB Dance (recommended for students that have taken Ballet. Often not compatible with CP schedules due to CTAE Pathway)
 IB Film HL (recommended for students interested in film analysis. Often not compatible with CP schedules due to CTAE Pathway)
 IB Theatre HL (recommended for students that have taken or participated in Theatre. Often not compatible with CP schedules due to CTAE Pathway)
 IB Visual Art HL (recommended for students that have previously taken Visual Arts. Often not compatible with CP schedules due to CTAE Pathway)
 IB Business Management (recommended for any student with an interest in Business Management)

NOTE: This form is just for the 2 to 5 IB courses, not including PPS. The remaining courses will be scheduled by your child's high school guidance counselor.

By signing this form, you understand the commitment of time and effort your child is undertaking if accepted into the International Baccalaureate Career-related Program at Jackson High School. This commitment includes agreeing to keep your child in the IB Career-related Program for at least one school year. Signing this form also verifies that you are aware of and have committed to completing the Reflective Project, Service Learning and Language Requirements, the Personal and Professional Skills (PPS) course, as well as the applicable internal and external assessments that are required by the International Baccalaureate Organization. Any academic, attendance, or behavioral problems may be sufficient cause to rescind any acceptance that may be granted. Generally, failing one or more IB courses can result in the student's removal from the IB Career-related Program. However, we generally DO NOT remove students from the IBCP unless they have exhibited poor academic performance or the IBCP impedes student graduation requirements. Signing also signifies your awareness that you may be responsible for the 10% to 25% of exam costs not covered by APS.
